- No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service by direct recruitment if he/she is less than twenty-five years or more than fifty years of age, on 31.05.2016 (last day of the month for submission of application) for the post of Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Sr. Resident, Demonstrator, Lecturer. Whereas, for the post of professor upper age limit is 62 years as on 31.05.2016, the last day of month for submission of application. For the post of Medical Superintendent the candidate should not be less than forty two years or more than fifty five years of age as on 31.05.2016. In case of JR and Casualty Medical Officers the age should not be more than forty two years for General category candidates as on 31.05.2016.
- > Tenure of post of Senior Resident is initially for one year which can be extended maximum period upto three years only. Tenure of post of Junior Resident will be six months extendable maximum one year.
